I John 1:1-10

That which was from the <u>beginning</u>, which we have <u>heard</u>, which we have seen with our <u>eyes</u>, which we have looked upon, and our <u>hands</u> have handled, of the <u>Word</u> of life; (For the life was manifested, and we have seen *it*, and bear <u>witness</u>, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the <u>Father</u>, and was manifested unto us;) That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have <u>fellowship</u> with us: and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father, and with his <u>Son Jesus Christ</u>. And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full. This then is the <u>message</u> which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that <u>God</u> is <u>light</u>, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in <u>darkness</u>, we lie, and do not the <u>truth</u>: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the <u>blood</u> of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we <u>deceive</u> ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we <u>confess</u> our <u>sins</u>, he is <u>faithful</u> and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
