And the LORD said unto him, Go, return on thy way to the wilderness of <u>Damascus</u>: and when thou comest, anoint <u>Hazael</u> to be king over <u>Syria</u>: And <u>Jehu</u> the son of Nimshi shalt thou anoint to <u>be</u> king over <u>Israel</u>: and <u>Elisha</u> the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah shalt thou anoint to <u>be</u> prophet in thy room. And it shall come to pass, <u>that</u> him that escapeth the sword of Hazael shall Jehu <u>slay</u>: and him that escapeth from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay. Yet I have left <u>me seven thousand</u> in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto <u>Baal</u>, and every mouth which hath not kissed him. So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was <u>plowing</u> with twelve
