1 Kings 9:1-9

And it came to pass, when <u>Solomon</u> had <u>finished</u> the <u>building</u> of the <u>house</u> of the <u>LORD</u>, and the king's house, and all Solomon's <u>desire</u> which he was pleased to do, That the LORD <u>appeared</u> to Solomon the <u>second</u> time, as he had appeared unto him at <u>Gibeon</u>. And the LORD said unto him, I have <u>heard</u> thy <u>prayer</u> and thy <u>supplication</u>, that thou hast made before me: I have <u>hallowed</u> this house, which thou hast built, to put my <u>name</u> there for ever; and mine eyes and mine <u>heart</u> shall be there <u>perpetually</u>. And if thou wilt <u>walk</u> before me, as <u>David</u> thy <u>father</u> walked, in <u>integrity</u> of heart, and in <u>uprightness</u>, to do according to all that I have <u>commanded</u> thee, and wilt keep my <u>statutes</u> and my <u>judgments</u>: Then I will <u>establish</u> the <u>throne</u> of thy <u>kingdom</u> upon <u>Israel</u> for ever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the throne of Israel. But if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your <u>children</u>, and will not keep my commandments and my statutes which I have set before you, but go and <u>serve</u> other gods, and <u>worship</u> them: Then will I cut off Israel out of the land which I have given them; and this house, which I have hallowed for my name, will I cast out of my sight; and Israel shall be a <u>proverb</u> and a byword among all people: And at this house, which is high, every one that passeth by it shall be <u>astonished</u>, and shall hiss; and they shall say, Why hath the LORD done thus unto this land, and to this house? And they shall answer, Because they <u>forsook</u> the LORD their <u>God</u>, who brought forth their fathers out of the land of <u>Egypt</u>, and have taken hold upon other gods, and have worshipped them, and served them: therefore hath the LORD brought upon them all this <u>evil</u>.

#### 1 Kings 9:1-9

And it was so, that when <u>Solomon</u> had made an end of praying all this <u>prayer</u> and <u>supplication</u> unto the <u>LORD</u>, he arose from before the <u>altar</u> of the LORD, from <u>kneeling</u> on his knees with his <u>hands</u> <u>spread</u> up to <u>heaven</u>. And he <u>stood</u>, and <u>blessed</u> all the <u>congregation</u> of <u>Israel</u> with a loud voice, saying, Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his <u>people</u> Israel, according to all that he <u>promised</u>: there hath not <u>failed</u> one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of <u>Moses</u> his <u>servant</u>. The LORD our God be with us, as he was with our <u>fathers</u>: let him not <u>leave</u> us, nor <u>forsake</u> us: That he may <u>incline</u> our <u>hearts</u> unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his <u>commandments</u>, and his <u>statutes</u>, and his <u>judgments</u>, which he commanded our fathers. And let these my <u>words</u>, wherewith I have made supplication before the LORD, be nigh unto the LORD our <u>God</u> day and night, that he maintain the <u>cause</u> of his servant, and the cause of his people Israel at all times, as the matter shall <u>require</u>: That all the people of the <u>earth</u> may know that the LORD is God, and that there is none else. Let your heart therefore be <u>perfect</u> with the LORD our God, to walk in his statutes, and to keep his commandments, as at this day.
