2 Corinthians 5:1-11

For we know that if our <u>earthly house</u> of *this* <u>tabernacle</u> were <u>dissolved</u>, we have a <u>building</u> of <u>God</u>, an house not made with hands, <u>eternal</u> in the <u>heavens</u>. For in this we <u>groan</u>, earnestly desiring to be <u>clothed</u> upon with our house which is from heaven: If so be that being clothed we shall not be <u>found</u> naked. For we that are in *this* tabernacle do groan, being <u>burdened</u>: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that <u>mortality</u> might be <u>swallowed</u> up of <u>life</u>. Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing *is* God, who also hath given unto us the <u>earnest</u> of the <u>Spirit</u>. Therefore *we are* always <u>confident</u>, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the <u>body</u>, we are <u>absent</u> from the <u>Lord</u>: (For we walk by <u>faith</u>, not by <u>sight</u>:) We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be <u>present</u> with the Lord. Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be <u>accepted</u> of him. For we must all appear before the <u>judgment seat</u> of <u>Christ</u>; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* <u>body</u>, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad. Knowing therefore the <u>terror</u> of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made <u>manifest</u> in your consciences.
