And thy carcase <u>shall</u> be <u>meat</u> unto all <u>fowls</u> of the air, and unto the <u>beasts</u> of the <u>earth</u>, and no man shall <u>fray</u> them away. The LORD will <u>smite</u> thee with the <u>botch</u> of <u>Egypt</u>, and with the emerods, and with the <u>scab</u>, and with the <u>itch</u>, whereof thou canst not be <u>healed</u>. The LORD shall smite thee with <u>madness</u>, and <u>blindness</u>, and <u>astonishment</u> of <u>heart</u>: And thou shalt <u>grope</u> at <u>noonday</u>, as the blind gropeth in <u>darkness</u>, and thou shalt not <u>prosper</u> in thy <u>ways</u>: and thou shalt be only <u>oppressed</u> and <u>spoiled</u> evermore, and no man shall <u>save</u> thee. Thou shalt <u>betroth</u> a <u>wife</u>, and <u>another</u> man shall lie with her: thou shalt <u>build</u> an <u>house</u>, and thou shalt not <u>dwell</u> therein: thou shalt <u>plant</u> a <u>vineyard</u>, and shalt not gather the <u>grapes</u> thereof. Thine ox <u>shall</u> be <u>slain</u> before thine <u>eyes</u>, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass <u>shall</u> be violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be <u>restored</u> to thee: thy <u>sheep</u> <u>shall</u> be given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to <u>rescue</u> them. Thy <u>sons</u> and thy <u>daughters</u> <u>shall</u> be given unto another <u>people</u>, and thine eyes shall look, and fail <u>with longing</u> for them all the day long: and there <u>shall</u> be no <u>might</u> in thine hand. The <u>fruit</u> of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a <u>nation</u> which <u>thou</u> knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only oppressed and <u>crushed</u> alway: So that thou shalt be mad for the <u>sight</u> of thine eyes which thou shalt see.
