Thou shalt have no <u>other</u> gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any <u>graven image</u>, or any likeness of any thing that is in <u>heaven</u> above, or that is in the <u>earth beneath</u>, or that is in the <u>water</u> under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a <u>jealous</u> God, visiting the <u>iniquity</u> of the fathers upon the <u>children</u> unto the <u>third</u> and <u>fourth generation</u> of them that hate me; And shewing <u>mercy</u> unto thousands of them that <u>love</u> me, and keep my commandments. Thou shalt not take the <u>name</u> of the LORD thy God in <u>vain</u>; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. <u>Remember</u> the <u>sabbath</u> day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy <u>work</u>: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy <u>daughter</u>, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy <u>cattle</u>, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and <u>rested</u> the <u>seventh</u> day: wherefore the LORD <u>blessed</u> the sabbath day, and <u>hallowed</u> it. <u>Honour</u> thy <u>father</u> and thy <u>mother</u>: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. Thou shalt not <u>kill</u>. Thou shalt not <u>commit adultery</u>. Thou shalt not <u>steal</u>. Thou shalt not bear <u>false</u> <u>witness</u> against thy neighbour. Thou shalt not <u>covet</u> thy neighbour's <u>house</u>, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's <u>wife</u>, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
