## Exodus 1:12-22

And they built for <u>Pharaoh</u> treasure cities, <u>Pithom</u> and <u>Raamses</u>. But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were grieved because of the children of <u>Israel</u>. But the midwives feared <u>God</u>, and did not as the king of Egypt <u>commanded</u> them, but saved the men children alive? And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have <u>saved</u> the men children alive? And the midwives come in unto them. Therefore God dealt well with the midwives: and the people <u>multiplied</u>, and waxed very mighty. And it came to pass, because the midwives <u>feared</u> God, that he made them houses. And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is <u>born</u> ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.
