Moreover the word of the <u>LORD</u> came unto me, saying, Son of man, take up a <u>lamentation</u> upon the <u>king</u> of <u>Tyrus</u>, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord <u>GOD</u>; Thou sealest up the sum, full of <u>wisdom</u>, and perfect in <u>beauty</u>. Thou hast been in <u>Eden</u> the garden of God; every precious stone *was* thy covering, the sardius, <u>topaz</u>, and the <u>diamond</u>, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the <u>sapphire</u>, the <u>emerald</u>, and the carbuncle, and <u>gold</u>: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. Thou *art* the anointed <u>cherub</u> that covereth; and I have set thee *so*: thou wast upon the holy <u>mountain</u> of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the <u>stones</u> of fire. Thou *wast* <u>perfect</u> in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till <u>iniquity</u> was found in thee. By the <u>multitude</u> of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with <u>violence</u>, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as <u>profane</u> out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. Thine <u>heart</u> was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast <u>corrupted</u> thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the <u>ground</u>, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. Thou hast defiled thy <u>sanctuaries</u> by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the <u>earth</u> in the sight of all them that behold thee. All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never *shalt* thou *be* any more.
