And the boys grew: and Esau was a cunning <u>hunter</u>, a man of the field; and Jacob <u>was</u> a plain man, dwelling in <u>tents</u>. And Isaac loved Esau, because he did eat of <u>his venison</u>: but Rebekah loved Jacob. And Jacob sod <u>pottage</u>: and Esau came from the field, and he <u>was faint</u>: And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red <u>pottage</u>; for I <u>am</u> faint: therefore was his name called <u>Edom</u>. And Jacob said, Sell me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob. Then Jacob gave Esau <u>bread</u> and pottage of <u>lentils</u>; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau <u>despised his</u> birthright.
