Genesis 27:1-20

And it came to pass, that when <u>Isaac</u> was old, and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called <u>Esau</u> his eldest son, and said unto him, My son: and he said unto him, Behold, *here am* I. And he said, Behold now, I am old, I know not the day of my <u>death</u>: Now therefore take, I pray thee, thy <u>weapons</u>, thy quiver and thy bow, and go out to the field, and take me <u>some venison</u>; And make me savoury meat, such as I love, and bring *it* to me, that I may eat; that my <u>soul</u> may bless thee before I die. And <u>Rebekah</u> heard when Isaac spake to Esau his son. And Esau went to the field to <u>hunt</u> for venison, and to bring *it*. And Rebekah spake unto <u>Jacob</u> her son, saying, Behold, I heard thy <u>father</u> speak unto Esau thy brother, saying, Bring me venison, and make me savoury meat, that I may eat, and bless thee before the <u>LORD</u> before my death. Now therefore, my son, obey my voice according to that which I command thee. Go now to the <u>flock</u>, and fetch me from thence two good kids of the <u>goats</u>; and I will make them savoury meat for thy father, such as he loveth: And thou shalt bring *it* to thy father, that he may eat, and that he may <u>bless</u> thee before his death. And Jacob said to Rebekah his mother, Behold, Esau my brother *is* a <u>hairy</u> man, and I *am* a smooth man: My father peradventure will feel me, and I shall seem to him as a <u>deceiver</u>; and I shall bring a <u>curse</u> upon me, and not a blessing. And his <u>mother</u> said unto him, Upon me *be* thy curse, my son: only obey my <u>voice</u>, and go fetch me *them*. And he went, and fetched, and brought *them* to his mother: and his mother made savoury <u>meat</u>, such as his father loved. And Rebekah took goodly <u>raiment</u> of her eldest son Esau, which were with her in the house, and put them upon Jacob her younger son: And she put the <u>skins</u> of the kids of the goats upon his hands, and upon the smooth of his neck: And she gave the savoury meat and the <u>bread</u>, which she had prepared, into the <u>hand</u> of her son Jacob.
