Genesis 32:1-12

And <u>Jacob</u> went on his way, and the <u>angels</u> of <u>God</u> met him. And when Jacob saw them, he said, This is God's <u>host</u>: and he called the name of that place <u>Mahanaim</u>. And Jacob sent <u>messengers</u> before him to <u>Esau</u> his <u>brother</u> unto the land of <u>Seir</u>, the <u>country</u> of <u>Edom</u>. And he commanded them, saying, Thus shall ye speak unto my lord Esau; Thy servant Jacob saith thus, I have sojourned with <u>Laban</u>, and stayed there until now: And I have <u>oxen</u>, and asses, flocks, and menservants, and womenservants: and I have sent to tell my lord, that I may find <u>grace</u> in thy sight. And the messengers <u>returned</u> to Jacob, saying, We came to thy brother Esau, and also he cometh to meet thee, and <u>four</u> <u>hundred</u> men with him. Then Jacob was greatly <u>afraid</u> and <u>distressed</u>: and he <u>divided</u> the <u>people</u> that was with him, and the <u>flocks</u>, and herds, and the camels, into two bands; And said, If Esau come to the one <u>company</u>, and smite it, then the other company which is left shall escape. And Jacob said, O God of my <u>father Abraham</u>, and God of my father <u>Isaac</u>, the <u>LORD</u> which saidst unto me, Return unto thy country, and to thy <u>kindred</u>, and I will deal well with thee: I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies, and of all the <u>truth</u>, which thou hast shewed unto thy servant; for with my staff I passed over this Jordan; and now I am become two bands. <u>Deliver</u> me, I pray thee, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau: for I fear him, lest he will come and smite me, and the <u>mother</u> with the <u>children</u>. And thou saidst, I will surely do thee good, and make thy seed as the sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered for <u>multitude</u>.
