Genesis 37:1-12

And <u>Jacob</u> dwelt in the land wherein his <u>father</u> was a stranger, in the land of <u>Canaa</u>n. These are the <u>generations</u> of Jacob. Joseph, being <u>seventeen</u> years old, was feeding the flock with his <u>brethren</u>; and the lad was with the sons of <u>Bilhah</u>, and with the sons of <u>Zilpah</u>, his father's wives: and Joseph brought unto his father their evil report. Now <u>Israel</u> loved Joseph more than all his <u>children</u>, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a <u>coat</u> of many colours. And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they <u>hated</u> him, and could not <u>speak</u> peaceably unto him. And Joseph <u>dreamed</u> a dream, and he told it his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: For, behold, we were binding <u>sheaves</u> in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made <u>obeisance</u> to my sheaf. And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed <u>reign</u> over us? or shalt thou indeed have <u>dominion</u> over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me. And he told it to his father, and to his brethren: and his father <u>rebuked</u> him, and said unto him, What is this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? And his brethren <u>envied</u> him; but his father observed the saying. And his brethren went to feed their father's flock in Shechem.
