Genesis 38:11-20

Then said <u>Judah</u> to <u>Tamar</u> his daughter in law, Remain a <u>widow</u> at thy father's house, till <u>Shelah</u> my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his <u>brethren</u> did. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house. And in process of time the daughter of Shuah Judah's wife died; and Judah was <u>comforted</u>, and went up unto his sheepshearers to Timnath, he and his friend Hirah the Adullamite. And he said, What pledge shall I give thee? And she said, Thy <u>signet</u>, and thy <u>bracelets</u>, and thy <u>staff</u> that is in thine hand.
