Now the <u>serpent</u> was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the <u>garden</u>? And the <u>woman</u> said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, <u>God</u> hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye <u>touch</u> it, lest ye die. And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be <u>opened</u>, and ye shall be as gods, knowing <u>good</u> and <u>evil</u>. And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* <u>wise</u>, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her <u>husband</u> with her; and he did eat. And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were <u>naked</u>; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden. And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where *art* thou? And he said, I heard thy <u>voice</u> in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself. And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.
