Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy <u>conception</u>; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. And unto <u>Adam</u> he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the <u>tree</u>, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: <u>cursed</u> is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; <u>Thorns</u> also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; In the <u>sweat</u> of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto <u>dust</u> shalt thou return. And Adam called his wife's name <u>Eve</u>; because she was the mother of all living. Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make <u>coats</u> of skins, and clothed them. And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know <u>good</u> and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of <u>life</u>, and eat, and live forever: Therefore the LORD <u>God</u> sent him forth from the garden of <u>Eden</u>, to till the ground from whence he was taken. So he drove out the man; and he placed at the <u>east</u> of the garden of Eden <u>Cherubims</u>, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.
