And <u>Joseph</u> brought them out from between his <u>knees</u>, and he bowed himself with his face to the earth. And Joseph took them both, <u>Ephraim</u> in his right hand toward Israel's left hand, and <u>Manasseh</u> in his left hand toward Israel's right hand, and brought *them* near unto him. And <u>Israel</u> stretched out his <u>right</u> hand, and laid *it* upon Ephraim's head, who *was* the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's <u>head</u>, guiding his hands wittingly; for Manasseh *was* the <u>firstborn</u>. And he blessed Joseph, and said, <u>God</u>, before whom my fathers <u>Abraham</u> and <u>Isaac</u> did walk, the God which fed me all my life long unto this day, The <u>Angel</u> which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the <u>earth</u>. And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to <u>remove</u> it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head. And Joseph said unto his father, Not so, my father: for this *is* the firstborn; put thy right hand upon his head. And his father <u>refused</u>, and said, I know *it*, my son, I know *it*: he also shall become a <u>people</u>, and he also shall be great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of <u>nations</u>. And he blessed them that day, saying, In thee shall Israel bless, saying, God make thee as Ephraim and as Manasseh: and he set Ephraim before Manasseh. And Israel said unto Joseph, Behold, I die: but God shall be with you, and <u>bring</u> you again unto the land of your fathers. Moreover I have given to thee one portion above thy <u>brethren</u>, which I took out of the hand of the <u>Amorite</u> with my sword and with my bow.
