And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every <u>creeping</u> thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man: All in whose <u>nostrils</u> was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry *land*, died. And every <u>living</u> substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were <u>destroyed</u> from the earth: and Noah only remained <u>alive</u>, and they that were with him in the ark. And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.
