## Genesis 8:1-12

And <u>God</u> remembered <u>Noah</u>, and every living thing, and all the cattle that *was* with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the <u>earth</u>, and the waters asswaged; The fountains also of the deep and the windows of <u>heaven</u> were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained; And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the <u>waters</u> were abated. And the <u>ark</u> rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of <u>Ararat</u>. And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth *month*, on the first *day* of the month, were the tops of the <u>mountains</u> seen. And it came to pass at the end of <u>forty</u> days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: And he sent forth a <u>raven</u>, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. Also he sent forth a <u>dove</u> from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground; But the dove found no rest for the sole of her <u>foot</u>, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters *were* on the <u>face</u> of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark. And he stayed yet other <u>seven</u> days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark; And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth *was* an <u>olive</u> leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were <u>abated</u> from off the earth. And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him anymore.
