And Noah builded an <u>altar</u> unto the <u>LORD</u>; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. And the LORD smelled a <u>sweet</u> savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again <u>curse</u> the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart *is* <u>evil</u> from his youth; neither will I again smite any more everything living, as I have done. While the earth remaineth, seedtime and <u>harvest</u>, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not <u>cease</u>.
