Hebrews 11:8-16

By faith Abraham, when he was <u>called</u> to go out into a <u>place</u> which he should after <u>receive</u> for an <u>inheritance</u>, <u>obeyed</u>; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he <u>sojourned</u> in the <u>land</u> of <u>promise</u>, as *in* a <u>strange</u> <u>country</u>, dwelling in <u>tabernacles</u> with <u>Isaac</u> and <u>Jacob</u>, the <u>heirs</u> with him of the same promise: For he looked for a <u>city</u> which hath <u>foundations</u>, whose <u>builder</u> and <u>maker</u> *is* <u>God</u>. Through faith also Sara herself received strength to <u>conceive</u> seed, and was delivered of a <u>child</u> when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, *so many* as the stars of the sky in <u>multitude</u>, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable. These all <u>died</u> in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of *them*, and <u>embraced</u> *them*, and <u>confessed</u> that they were <u>strangers</u> and <u>pilgrims</u> on the earth. For they that say such things <u>declare</u> plainly that they seek a country. And truly, if they had been mindful of that *country* from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. But now they <u>desire</u> a <u>better</u> *country*, that is, an <u>heavenly</u>: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath <u>prepared</u> for them a city.
