Hebrews 9:1-14

Then verily the first <u>covenant</u> had also ordinances of <u>divine</u> service, and a worldly sanctuary. For there was a <u>tabernacle</u> made; the first, wherein <u>was</u> the <u>candlestick</u>, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the <u>sanctuary</u>. And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the <u>Holiest</u> of all; Which had the golden censer, and the <u>ark</u> of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein <u>was</u> the golden pot that had <u>manna</u>, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; And over it the <u>cherubims</u> of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly. Now when these things were thus ordained, the <u>priests</u> went always into the <u>first</u> tabernacle, accomplishing the service <u>of <u>God</u>. But into the <u>second went</u> the <u>high</u> priest alone <u>once</u> every year, not without <u>blood</u>, which he offered for himself, and <u>for</u> the errors of the people: The <u>Holy Ghost</u> this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet <u>standing</u>: Which <u>was</u> a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both <u>gifts</u> and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the <u>conscience</u>; <u>Which stood</u> only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed <u>on them</u> until the time of <u>reformation</u>. But <u>Christ</u> being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect <u>tabernacle</u>, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this <u>building</u>; Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained <u>eternal redemption</u> <u>for us</u>. For if the blood of Christ, who through the eternal <u>Spirit</u> offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from <u>dead</u> works to serve the <u>living</u> God?</u>
