Is any <u>sick</u> among you? let him call for the <u>elders</u> of the <u>church</u>; and let them pray over him, <u>anointing</u> him with oil in the name of the <u>Lord</u>: And the prayer of <u>faith</u> shall save the sick, and the Lord shall <u>raise</u> him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. <u>Confess your faults</u> one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be <u>healed</u>. The <u>effectual fervent prayer</u> of a <u>righteous</u> man availeth much. <u>Elias</u> was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not <u>rain</u>: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. And he prayed again, and the <u>heaven</u> gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit. Brethren, if any of you do err from the <u>truth</u>, and one <u>convert</u> him; Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from <u>death</u>, and shall hide a multitude of sins.
