## John 7:1-13

After these things <u>Jesus</u> walked in <u>Galilee</u>: for he would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill him. Now the Jews' <u>feast</u> of <u>tabernacles</u> was at hand. His <u>brethren</u> therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into <u>Judaea</u>, that thy <u>disciples</u> also may see the works that thou doest. For *there is* no man *that* doeth anything in <u>secret</u>, and he himself seeketh to be known <u>openly</u>. If thou do these things, shew thyself to the world. For neither did his brethren believe in him. Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is alway ready. The <u>world</u> cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are <u>evil</u>. Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up yet unto this feast; for my time is not yet full come. When he had said these words unto them, he abode *still* in Galilee. But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret. Then the <u>Jews</u> sought him at the feast, and said, Where is he? And there was much <u>murmuring</u> among the <u>people</u> concerning him: for some said, He is a good man: others said, Nay; but he deceiveth the people. Howbeit no man spake openly of him for fear of the Jews.
