Leviticus 7:1-15

Likewise this *is* the law of the trespass offering: it *is* most holy. In the place where they kill the burnt offering shall they kill the trespass offering: and the blood thereof shall he <u>sprinkle</u> round about upon the <u>altar</u>. And he shall offer of it all the fat thereof; the rump, and the fat that covereth the inwards, And the two <u>kidneys</u>, and the fat that *is* on them, which *is* by the flanks, and the caul *that is* above the liver, with the kidneys, it shall he take away: And the <u>priest</u> shall burn them upon the altar *for* an offering made by fire unto the <u>LORD</u>: it *is* a trespass offering. Every male among the priests shall eat thereof: it shall be eaten in the <u>holy</u> place: it *is* most holy. As the sin offering *is*, so *is* the trespass offering: *there is* one law for them: the priest that maketh <u>atonement</u> therewith shall have *it*. And the priest that offereth any man's <u>burnt</u> offering, *even* the priest shall have to himself the skin of the burnt offering which he hath offered. And all the <u>meat</u> offering that is baken in the <u>oven</u>, and all that is dressed in the fryingpan, and in the pan, shall be the priest's that offereth it. And every meat offering, mingled with oil, and dry, shall all the sons of <u>Aaron</u> have, one *as much* as another. And this *is* the law of the sacrifice of <u>peace</u> offerings, which he shall offer unto the LORD. If he offer it for a <u>thanksgiving</u>, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened <u>cakes</u> mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried. Besides the cakes, he shall offer *for* his offering leavened <u>bread</u> with the <u>sacrifice</u> of thanksgiving of his peace offerings. And of it he shall offer one out of the whole oblation *for* an heave offering thanksgiving shall be eaten the same day that it is offered; he shall not leave any of it until the <u>morning</u>.
