Luke 14:25-34

And there went <u>great multitudes</u> with him: and he turned, and said unto them, If any *man* come to me, and <u>hate</u> not his <u>father</u>, and <u>mother</u>, and <u>wife</u>, and <u>children</u>, and <u>brethren</u>, and <u>sisters</u>, yea, and his own <u>life</u> also, he cannot be my disciple. And whosoever doth not bear his <u>cross</u>, and come after me, cannot be my <u>disciple</u>. For which of you, intending to build a <u>tower</u>, sitteth not down first, and <u>counteth</u> the cost, whether he have *sufficient* to finish *it*? Lest haply, after he hath laid the <u>foundation</u>, and is not able to finish *it*, all that behold *it* begin to mock him, Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to <u>finish</u>. Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh <u>against</u> him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth <u>conditions</u> of peace. So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple. <u>Salt</u> *is* good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned? It is neither fit for the <u>land</u>, nor yet for the dunghill; *but* men cast it out. He that hath ears to hear, let him <u>hear</u>.
