Luke 16:10-18

He that is <u>faithful</u> in that which is <u>least</u> is faithful also in <u>much</u>: and he that is <u>unjust</u> in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous <u>mammon</u>, who will commit to your <u>trust</u> the <u>true riches</u>? And if ye have not been faithful in that which is <u>another</u> man's, who shall give you that which is your own? No <u>servant</u> can <u>serve</u> two <u>masters</u>: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and <u>despise</u> the other. Ye cannot serve <u>God</u> and mammon. And the <u>Pharisees</u> also, who were <u>covetous</u>, heard all these things: and they <u>derided</u> him. And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your <u>hearts</u>: for that which is highly <u>esteemed</u> among men is <u>abomination</u> in the sight of God. The law and the <u>prophets</u> were until John: since that time the <u>kingdom</u> of God is preached, and every man presseth into it. And it is easier for <u>heaven</u> and <u>earth</u> to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail. Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth <u>adultery</u>: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from *her* husband committeth adultery.
