Malachi 3:7-18

Even from the days of your <u>fathers</u> ye are gone away from mine <u>ordinances</u>, and have not kept *them*. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the <u>LORD</u> of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return? Will a man rob <u>God</u>? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In <u>tithes</u> and <u>offerings</u>. Ye *are* cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, *even* this whole <u>nation</u>. Bring ye all the tithes into the <u>storehouse</u>, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of <u>hosts</u>, if I will not open you the windows of <u>heaven</u>, and pour you out a <u>blessing</u>, that *there shall* not *be room* enough *to receive it*. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. And all <u>nations</u> shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts. Your words have been stout against me, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, What have we spoken *so much* against thee? Ye have said, It *is* vain to serve God: and what <u>profit</u> *is it* that we have kept his <u>ordinance</u>, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts? And now we call the <u>proud</u> happy: yea, they that work <u>wickedness</u> are set up; yea, *they that* tempt God are even delivered. Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard *it*, and a book of <u>remembrance</u> was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.
