Matthew 12:38-50

Then <u>certain</u> of the <u>scribes</u> and of the <u>Pharisees</u> answered, saying, <u>Master</u>, we would see a <u>sign</u> from thee. But he answered and said unto them, An <u>evil</u> and <u>adulterous generation</u> seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the <u>prophet Jonas</u>: For as Jonas was <u>three</u> days and three nights in the <u>whale's belly</u>; so shall the Son of man be three days and three <u>nights</u> in the <u>heart</u> of the <u>earth</u>. The men of <u>Nineveh</u> shall rise in <u>judgment</u> with this generation, and shall <u>condemn</u> it: because they <u>repented</u> at the <u>preaching</u> of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas *is* here. The <u>queen</u> of the <u>south</u> shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and <u>shall</u> condemn it: for she came from the uttermost <u>parts</u> of the earth to hear the <u>wisdom</u> of <u>Solomon</u>; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here. When the <u>unclean spirit</u> is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry <u>places</u>, seeking <u>rest</u>, and findeth none. Then he saith, I will return into my <u>house</u> from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth *it* <u>empty</u>, <u>swept</u>, and <u>qarnished</u>. Then goeth he, and taketh with himself <u>seven</u> other spirits <u>more</u> wicked than himself, and they <u>enter</u> in and dwell there: and the last <u>state</u> of that man is <u>worse</u> than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation. While he yet talked to the people, behold, <u>his</u> <u>mother</u> and his <u>brethren</u> stood without, desiring to speak with him. Then one said unto him, <u>Behold</u>, thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to speak with thee. But he answered and said unto him that told him, Who is my mother? and who are my brethren? And he <u>stretched</u> forth his hand <u>toward</u> his <u>disciples</u>, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren! For whoseever shall do the <u>will of my Father</u> which is in <u>heaven</u>, the <u>same</u> is my <u>brother</u>, and <u>sister</u>, and mother.
