Matthew 23:1-16

Then spake <u>Jesus</u> to the <u>multitude</u>, and to his <u>disciples</u>, Saying, The <u>scribes</u> and the <u>Pharisees</u> sit in <u>Moses' seat</u>: All therefore whatsoever they bid you <u>observe</u>, *that* observe and do; but do not ye <u>after</u> their <u>works</u>: for they say, and do not. For they bind heavy <u>burdens</u> and grievous to be borne, and lay *them* on men's shoulders; but they *themselves* will not move them with one of their fingers. But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the <u>borders</u> of their garments, And love the uppermost rooms at <u>feasts</u>, and the chief seats in the <u>synagogues</u>, And greetings in the <u>markets</u>, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi. But be not ye called <u>Rabbi</u>: for one is your Master, *even* Christ; and all ye are <u>brethren</u>. And call no *man* your <u>father</u> upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven. Neither be ye called masters: for one is your <u>Master</u>, *even* <u>Christ</u>. But he that is <u>greatest</u> among you shall be your <u>servant</u>. And whosoever shall <u>exalt</u> himself shall be <u>abased</u>; and he that shall <u>humble</u> himself shall be exalted. But <u>woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye <u>shut</u> up the <u>kingdom</u> of <u>heaven against</u> men: for ye <u>neither</u> go in *yourselves*, neither <u>suffer</u> ye them that are entering to go in. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour <u>widows' houses</u>, and for a pretence make long <u>prayer</u>: therefore ye shall receive the greater <u>damnation</u>. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, <u>hypocrites!</u> for ye compass <u>sea</u> and <u>land</u> to make one <u>proselyte</u>, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the <u>child</u> of <u>hell</u> than yourselves. <u>Woe</u> unto you, <u>ye blind</u> guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is <u>nothing</u>; but whosoever shall <u>swear</u> by the <u>gold</u> of the <u>temple</u>, he is a <u>debtor!</u>
