Matthew 23:17-33

Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold? And, Whosoever shall swear by the <u>altar</u>, it is nothing; but whosoever sweareth by the <u>gift</u> that is upon it, he is <u>guilty</u>. Ye fools and blind: for whether *is* <u>greater</u>, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift? Whoso therefore shall swear by the altar, sweareth by it, and by all <u>things</u> thereon. And whoso shall swear by the temple, sweareth by it, and by him that dwelleth therein. And he that shall swear by <u>heaven</u>, sweareth by the <u>throne</u> of <u>God</u>, and by him that sitteth thereon. Woe unto you, <u>scribes</u> and <u>Pharisees</u>, <u>hypocrites</u>! for ye pay tithe of <u>mint</u> and <u>anise</u> and <u>cummin</u>, and have omitted the <u>weightier</u> <u>matters</u> of the <u>law</u>, judgment, <u>mercy</u>, and <u>faith</u>: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Ye blind <u>guides</u>, which <u>strain</u> at a <u>gnat</u>, and <u>swallow</u> a <u>camel</u>. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make <u>clean</u> the <u>outside</u> of the <u>cup</u> and of the <u>platter</u>, but within they are full of <u>extortion</u> and <u>excess</u>. *Thou* blind Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto <u>whited sepulchres</u>, which indeed <u>appear beautiful outward</u>, but are within full of dead *men's* bones, and of all uncleanness. Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and <u>iniguity</u>. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the <u>tombs</u> of the <u>prophets</u>, and <u>garnish</u> the sepulchres of the righteous, And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the <u>blood</u> of the prophets. Wherefore ye be <u>witnesses</u> unto yourselves, that ye are the <u>children</u> of them which killed the prophets. Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers. Ye serpents, ye generation of <u>vipers</u>, how can ye <u>escape</u> the damnation of hell?
