Now the first *day* of the *feast of* <u>unleavened bread</u> the disciples came to <u>Jesus</u>, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the <u>Passover</u>? And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The <u>Master</u> saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the Passover at thy house with my <u>disciples</u>. And the disciples did as Jesus had appointed them; and they made ready the Passover. Now when the even was come, he sat down with the <u>twelve</u>. And as they did eat, he said, Verily I say unto you, that one of you shall <u>betray</u> me. And they were exceeding <u>sorrowful</u>, and began every one of them to say unto him, <u>Lord</u>, is it I? And he answered and said, He that dippeth *his* hand with me in the <u>dish</u>, the same shall betray me. The Son of man goeth as it is written of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born. Then <u>Judas</u>, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, Thou hast said. And as they were eating, Jesus took <u>bread</u>, and <u>blessed</u> *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my <u>body</u>. And he took the <u>cup</u>, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, <u>Drink</u> ye all of it; For this is my <u>blood</u> of the new testament, which is shed for many for the <u>remission</u> of <u>sins</u>. But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's <u>kingdom</u>. And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of <u>Olives</u>.
