Then cometh <u>Jesus</u> with them unto a place called <u>Gethsemane</u>, and saith unto the <u>disciples</u>, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder. And he took with him <u>Peter</u> and the two sons of <u>Zebedee</u>, and began to be sorrowful and very <u>heavy</u>. Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding <u>sorrowful</u>, even unto <u>death</u>: tarry ye here, and watch with me. And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and <u>prayed</u>, saying, O my <u>Father</u>, if it be <u>possible</u>, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou *wilt*. And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them <u>asleep</u>, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not <u>watch</u> with me one <u>hour</u>? Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the <u>spirit</u> indeed *is* willing, but the <u>flesh</u> *is* weak. He went away again the <u>second</u> time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I <u>drink</u> it, thy will be done. And he came and found them asleep again: for their <u>eyes</u> were heavy. And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the <u>third</u> time, saying the same words.
