Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a <u>tooth</u> for a tooth: But I say unto you, That ye <u>resist</u> not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right <u>cheek</u>, turn to him the other also. And if any man will sue thee at the law, and take away thy <u>coat</u>, let him have thy cloke also. And whosoever shall compel thee to go a <u>mile</u>, go with him twain. Give to him that asketh thee, and from him that would <u>borrow</u> of thee turn not thou away. Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt <u>love</u> thy neighbour, and <u>hate</u> thine enemy. But I say unto you, Love your <u>enemies</u>, <u>bless</u> them that <u>curse</u> you, do good to them that hate you, and <u>pray</u> for them which despitefully use you, and <u>persecute</u> you; That ye may be the <u>children</u> of your <u>Father</u> which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the <u>good</u>, and sendeth <u>rain</u> on the just and on the unjust. For if ye love them which love you, what <u>reward</u> have ye? do not even the publicans the same? And if ye salute your <u>brethren</u> only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? Be ye therefore <u>perfect</u>, even as your Father which is in <u>heaven</u> is perfect.

Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
