## Philippians 4:10-23

But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath <u>flourished</u> again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked <u>opportunity</u>. Not that I speak in <u>respect</u> of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, *therewith* to be <u>content</u>. I know both how to be <u>abased</u>, and I know how to <u>abound</u>: everywhere and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be <u>hungry</u>, both to abound and to <u>suffer</u> need. I can do all things through <u>Christ</u> which strengtheneth me. Notwithstanding ye have well done, that ye did communicate with my <u>affliction</u>. Now ye <u>Philippians</u> know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from <u>Macedonia</u>, no church communicated with me as concerning <u>giving</u> and receiving, but ye only. For even in <u>Thessalonica</u> ye sent once and again unto my necessity. Not because I desire a <u>gift</u>: but I desire <u>fruit</u> that may abound to your <u>account</u>. But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of <u>Epaphroditus</u> the things *which were sent* from you, an odour of a <u>sweet</u> smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to <u>God</u>. But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in <u>glory</u> by Christ <u>Jesus</u>. Now unto God and our <u>Father be</u> glory for ever and ever. Amen. Salute every <u>saint</u> in Christ Jesus. The brethren which are with me greet you. All the saints <u>salute</u> you, chiefly they that are of <u>Caesar</u>'s household. The <u>grace</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you all. <u>Amen</u>.
