Proverbs 19:1-14

Better *is* the <u>poor</u> that walketh in his <u>integrity</u>, than *he that is* <u>perverse</u> in his lips, and is a <u>fool</u>. Also, *that* the <u>soul</u> *be* <u>without</u> knowledge, *it is* not good; and he that hasteth with *his* feet sinneth. The foolishness of man perverteth his way: and his <u>heart</u> fretteth against the <u>LORD</u>. <u>Wealth</u> maketh many <u>friends</u>; but the poor is separated from his <u>neighbour</u>. A false <u>witness</u> shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall not escape. Many will intreat the favour of the <u>prince</u>: and every man *is* a friend to him that giveth <u>gifts</u>. All the <u>brethren</u> of the poor do <u>hate</u> him: how much more do his friends go far from him? He pursueth *them with* <u>words</u>, *yet* they *are* wanting *to him*. He that getteth <u>wisdom</u> loveth his own soul: he that keepeth <u>understanding</u> shall find good. A <u>false</u> witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall <u>perish</u>. Delight is not seemly for a fool; much less for a <u>servant</u> to have rule over <u>princes</u>. The discretion of a man deferreth his <u>anger</u>; and *it is* his glory to pass over a transgression. The king's wrath *is* as the <u>roaring</u> of a lion; but his favour *is* as dew upon the grass. A foolish son *is* the <u>calamity</u> of his father: and the contentions of a wife *are* a continual dropping. House and riches *are* the <u>inheritance</u> of fathers: and a <u>prudent</u> wife *is* from the LORD.
