Proverbs 19:1-14

Better *is* the poor that walketh in his integrity, than *he that is* perverse in his lips, and is a fool. Also, *that* the soul *be* without knowledge, *it is* not good; and he that hasteth with *his* feet sinneth. The foolishness of man perverteth his way: and his heart fretteth against the LORD. Wealth maketh many friends; but the poor is separated from his neighbour. A false witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall not escape. Many will intreat the favour of the prince: and every man *is* a friend to him that giveth gifts. All the brethren of the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? He pursueth *them* with words, yet they *are* wanting *to him*. He that getteth wisdom loveth his own soul: he that keepeth understanding shall find good. A false witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall perish. Delight is not seemly for a fool; much less for a servant to have rule over princes. The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and *it is* his glory to pass over a transgression. The king's wrath *is* as the roaring of a lion; but his favour *is* as dew upon the grass. A foolish son *is* the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife *are* a continual dropping. House and riches *are* the inheritance of fathers: and a prudent wife *is* from the LORD.
