Proverbs 19:15-29

Slothfulness casteth into a deep <u>sleep</u>; and an idle soul shall suffer <u>hunger</u>. He that keepeth the <u>commandment</u> keepeth his own soul; *but* he that despiseth his ways shall die. He that hath <u>pity</u> upon the <u>poor</u> lendeth unto the <u>LORD</u>; and that which he hath given will he pay him again. Chasten thy son while there is <u>hope</u>, and let not thy soul spare for his crying. A man of great <u>wrath</u> shall suffer punishment: for if thou deliver *him*, yet thou must do it again. Hear <u>counsel</u>, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be <u>wise</u> in thy latter end. *There are* many <u>devices</u> in a man's <u>heart</u>; nevertheless the counsel of the LORD, that shall stand. The desire of a man *is* his <u>kindness</u>: and a poor man *is* better than a <u>liar</u>. The fear of the LORD *tendeth* to <u>life</u>: and *he that hath it* shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with <u>evil</u>. A slothful *man* hideth his hand in *his* bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his <u>mouth</u> again. Smite a <u>scorner</u>, and the simple will <u>beware</u>: and <u>reprove</u> one that hath understanding, *and* he will understand knowledge. He that wasteth *his* father, *and* chaseth away *his* <u>mother</u>, *is* a son that causeth shame, and bringeth <u>reproach</u>. Cease, my son, to hear the <u>instruction</u> *that* causeth to err from the words of knowledge. An ungodly <u>witness</u> scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the <u>wicked</u> devoureth <u>iniquity</u>. Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of <u>fools</u>.
