Proverbs 27:1-14

Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth. Let another man <u>praise</u> thee, and not thine own mouth; a <u>stranger</u>, and not thine own lips. A stone *is* heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath *is* heavier than them both. <u>Wrath</u> *is* cruel, and <u>anger</u> *is* outrageous; but who *is* able to stand before <u>envy</u>? Open <u>rebuke</u> *is* better than <u>secret</u> love. <u>Faithful</u> *are* the wounds of a friend; but the <u>kisses</u> of an enemy *are* deceitful. The full soul loatheth an honeycomb; but to the <u>hungry</u> soul every bitter thing is sweet. As a <u>bird</u> that wandereth from her nest, so *is* a man that wandereth from his <u>place</u>. Ointment and <u>perfume</u> rejoice the heart: so *doth* the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty <u>counsel</u>. Thine own friend, and thy father's friend, forsake not; neither go into thy brother's house in the day of thy <u>calamity</u>: *for* better *is* a neighbour *that is* near than a <u>brother</u> far off. My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him that reproacheth me. A prudent *man* foreseeth the <u>evil</u>, *and* hideth himself; *but* the <u>simple</u> pass on, *and* are punished. Take his garment that is <u>surety</u> for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman. He that blesseth his <u>friend</u> with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.
