The <u>lambs</u> <u>are</u> for thy clothing, and the <u>goats</u> <u>are</u> the price of the field. And <u>thou shalt have</u> goats' milk enough for thy food, for the <u>food</u> of thy household, and <u>for</u> the maintenance for thy maidens.
