The <u>wicked</u> is snared by the <u>transgression</u> of his lips: but the just shall come out of <u>trouble</u>. A man shall be <u>satisfied</u> with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him. The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto <u>counsel</u> is wise. A fool's wrath is presently known: but a <u>prudent</u> man covereth shame. He that speaketh truth sheweth forth righteousness: but a false <u>witness</u> deceit. There is that speaketh like the <u>piercings</u> of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is <u>health</u>. The lip of <u>truth</u> shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment. <u>Deceit</u> is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace is joy. There shall no evil happen to the just: but the wicked shall be filled with mischief. Lying lips are <u>abomination</u> to the <u>LORD</u>: but they that deal truly are his delight. A prudent man concealeth <u>knowledge</u>: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness. The hand of the <u>diligent</u> shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute. Heaviness in the <u>heart</u> of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad. The righteous is more excellent than his neighbour: but the way of the wicked seduceth them. The slothful man roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the <u>substance</u> of a diligent man is <u>precious</u>.
