Proverbs 14:17-35

He that is soon <u>angry</u> dealeth foolishly: and a man of <u>wicked</u> devices is hated. The <u>simple</u> inherit folly: but the <u>prudent</u> are crowned with knowledge. The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the <u>righteous</u>. The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich hath many friends. He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath <u>mercy</u> on the poor, happy is he. Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and <u>truth</u> shall be to them that devise good. In all labour there is <u>profit</u>: but the talk of the lips tendeth only to penury. The <u>crown</u> of the wise is their <u>riches</u>: but the foolishness of fools is folly. A true <u>witness</u> delivereth souls: but a <u>deceitful</u> witness speaketh lies. In the fear of the <u>LORD</u> is strong <u>confidence</u>: and his children shall have a place of <u>refuge</u>. The fear of the LORD is a <u>fountain</u> of life, to depart from the snares of death. In the multitude of <u>people</u> is the king's honour: but in the want of people is the <u>destruction</u> of the prince. He that is slow to wrath is of great <u>understanding</u>: but he that spire spirit exalteth folly. A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the <u>rottenness</u> of the bones. He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his <u>Maker</u>: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor. The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his <u>death</u>. Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but that which is in the midst of fools is made known. Righteousness exalteth a <u>nation</u>: but sin is a reproach to any people. The king's favour is toward a wise <u>servant</u>: but his wrath is against him that causeth <u>shame</u>.
