## Proverbs 20:16-30

Take his <u>garment</u> that is surety *for* a <u>stranger</u>: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman. Bread of <u>deceit</u> is <u>sweet</u> to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel. *Every* <u>purpose</u> is established by counsel: and with good <u>advice</u> make war. He that goeth about *as* a talebearer revealeth <u>secrets</u>: therefore <u>meddle</u> not with him that flattereth with his lips. Whoso curseth his father or his <u>mother</u>, his lamp shall be put out in obscure <u>darkness</u>. An <u>inheritance</u> *may be* gotten hastily at the beginning; but the end thereof shall not be <u>blessed</u>. Say not thou, I will recompense <u>evil</u>; *but* wait on the <u>LORD</u>, and he shall save thee. Divers <u>weights</u> *are* an <u>abomination</u> unto the LORD; and a false <u>balance</u> *is* not good. Man's goings *are* of the LORD; how can a man then <u>understand</u> his own way? *It is* a <u>snare</u> to the man *who* devoureth *that which is* <u>holy</u>, and after vows to make enquiry. A <u>wise</u> king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them. The <u>spirit</u> of man *is* the <u>candle</u> of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. <u>Mercy</u> and <u>truth</u> preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy. The <u>glory</u> of <u>young</u> men *is* their <u>strength</u>: and the <u>beauty</u> of old men *is* the <u>gray</u> head. The blueness of a <u>wound</u> cleanseth away evil: so *do* stripes the inward parts of the belly.
