Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his <u>father</u>: but he that keepeth <u>company</u> with <u>harlots</u> spendeth his <u>substance</u>. The king by <u>judgment</u> establisheth the land: but he that receiveth gifts overthroweth it. A man that flattereth his neighbour spreadeth a net for his feet. In the <u>transgression</u> of an evil man there is a snare: but the righteous doth sing and rejoice. The righteous considereth the <u>cause</u> of the poor: but the wicked regardeth not to know it. <u>Scornful</u> men bring a city into a <u>snare</u>: but wise men turn away wrath. If a wise man contendeth with a <u>foolish</u> man, whether he rage or laugh, there is no rest. The <u>bloodthirsty</u> hate the upright: but the just seek his soul. A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards. If a ruler hearken to lies, all his <u>servants</u> are wicked. The poor and the deceitful man meet together: the <u>LORD</u> lighteneth both their eyes. The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever. The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a <u>child</u> left to himself bringeth his <u>mother</u> to shame. When the wicked are <u>multiplied</u>, transgression increaseth: but the righteous shall see their fall. <u>Correct</u> thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.
