Remove thy way far from her, and come not nigh the door of her <u>house</u>: Lest thou give thine honour unto others, and thy years unto the cruel: Lest <u>strangers</u> be filled with thy <u>wealth</u>; and thy labours be in the house of a stranger; And thou <u>mourn</u> at the last, when thy flesh and thy body are consumed, And say, How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised <u>reproof</u>; And have not obeyed the voice of my <u>teachers</u>, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me! I was almost in all evil in the midst of the <u>congregation</u> and <u>assembly</u>. Drink waters out of thine own well. Let thy <u>fountains</u> be dispersed abroad, and rivers of waters in the <u>streets</u>. Let them be only thine own, and not strangers' with thee. Let thy fountain be blessed: and rejoice with the wife of thy <u>youth</u>. Let her be as the loving hind and <u>pleasant</u> roe; let her breasts satisfy thee at all times; and be thou ravished always with her love. And why wilt thou, my son, be ravished with a strange woman, and embrace the bosom of a stranger? For the ways of man are before the eyes of the <u>LORD</u>, and he pondereth all his goings. His own <u>iniquities</u> shall take the <u>wicked</u> himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins. He shall die without instruction; and in the greatness of his folly he shall go <u>astray</u>.
