For I said in my <u>haste</u>, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou heardest the voice of my <u>supplications</u> when I cried unto thee. O love the LORD, all ye his <u>saints</u>: *for* the LORD preserveth the <u>faithful</u>, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer. Be of good <u>courage</u>, and he shall strengthen your <u>heart</u>, all ye that hope in the LORD.
