Romans 6:1-18

What shall we say then? Shall we <u>continue</u> in sin, that <u>grace</u> may abound? <u>God</u> forbid. How shall we, that are <u>dead</u> to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were <u>baptized</u> into <u>Jesus Christ</u> were baptized into his death? Therefore we are <u>buried</u> with him by <u>baptism</u> into death: that like as Christ was <u>raised</u> up from the dead by the <u>glory</u> of the <u>Father</u>, even so we also should <u>walk</u> in newness of life. For if we have been <u>planted</u> together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also *in the likeness* of *his* <u>resurrection</u>: Knowing this, that our old man is <u>crucified</u> with *him*, that the body of sin might be <u>destroyed</u>, that henceforth we should not <u>serve</u> sin. For he that is dead is <u>freed</u> from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we <u>believe</u> that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more <u>dominion</u> over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but <u>alive</u> unto God through Jesus Christ our <u>Lord</u>. Let not sin therefore <u>reign</u> in your <u>mortal</u> body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield ye your members <u>as instruments</u> of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your <u>members as instruments of righteousness</u> unto God. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God <u>forbid</u>. Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves <u>servants</u> to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye <u>obey</u>; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the <u>heart</u> that form of <u>doctrine</u> which was <u>delivered</u> you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.
